**An Act to Amend the  
New Brunswick Architects' Act**

WHEREAS the Architects' Association of New Brunswick has by its petition prayed that the Act governing the Association be revised and amended as hereinafter set forth;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to grant the prayer in the said petition;

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick, enacts as follows:

*1 Subsection 22(1) of the New Brunswick Architects' Act, chapter 52 of 19 Elizabeth II, 1970, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:*

*22(1) In this section "building" means only buildings to which Part 9 of the National Building Code of Canada 1977 has application.*

*2 Section 34 of the said Act is renumbered as section 35.*

*3 Section 38 of the said Act is amended by deleting the numbers 35 and 36 as they appear in the fourth line thereof and substituting therefore the numbers 36 and 37.*

*4 Subsection 39(5) of the said Act is amended by deleting the number 26 where it appears in the last line thereof and substituting therefore the number 27.*
