**An Act to Amend An Act to Authorize
the Establishment of a Commission to Control
Parking in the City of Saint John**

WHEREAS the City of Saint John has by its petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to grant the prayer in the said petition;

THEREFORE, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick, enacts as follows:

1 Subsection 2 of section 2 of An Act to Authorize the Establishment of a Commission to Control Parking in the City of Saint John, Chapter 128 of 3 Elizabeth II, 1956 and amendments thereto is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

2(2) The terms of office of the members of the Commission shall be three years from the date of their appointment or until their successors are appointed, but in the appointment of the first members to constitute the Commission after the coming into force of this Act, the Common Council may provide that certain of the members shall be appointed for periods of less than three years in order that all the members of the Commission shall not retire at the same time.
