

President's Medal and Distinguished Service Awards

Criteria

The following criteria shall guide the Selection Committee in recommending individuals for the President's Medal and Distinguished Service Awards.

President's Medal

- The nominee has had a distinguished career with the University of New Brunswick.
- Particular emphasis will be placed on distinctive contributions that have had a wide-ranging and enhancing influence on the university community and to the advancement of the University's strategic priorities.
- The recipient demonstrates excellence in their area of work and pursues excellence through actions.
- The nominee's work has enhanced student success or the core mission and values of the University. This includes contribution to the community or the University which impacts students and/or the University.
- The nominee has championed initiatives which have made a significant and lasting impact on the University.
- The nominee demonstrates and advances inclusive excellence, including efforts which support and advance UNB's equity, diversity and inclusion priorities and goals.

Distinguished Service Award

- The nominee clearly demonstrates work beyond normal requirements of their role over a sustained period of time. Emphasis will be placed on this category.
- The nominee's achievements have had a broad impact and have contributed to the University's success.
- The nominee exemplifies outstanding performance and is considered a role model for others.
- The nominee demonstrates exceptional and inspirational leadership.
- The nominee demonstrates commitment to service within their unit and the university community as a whole.
- The nominee is involved in the university community, including volunteering at staff, student or other University events.
