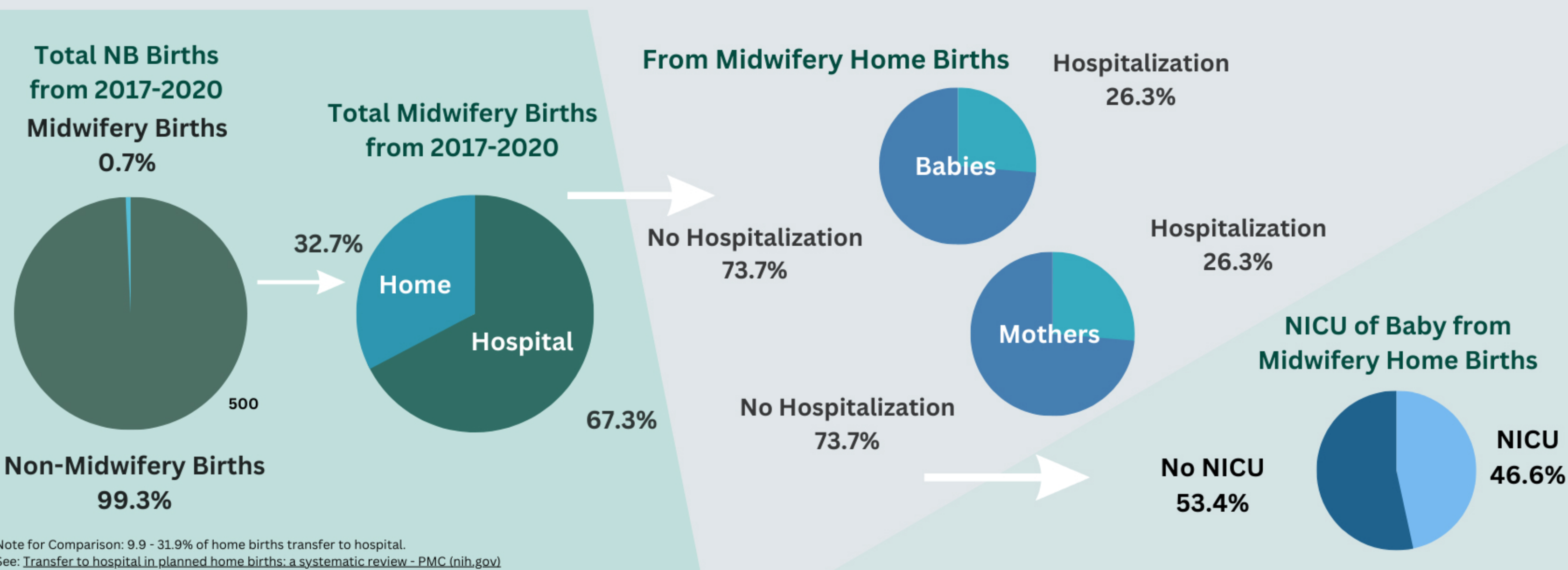


An Examination of Midwifery Practice in New Brunswick using Administrative Data

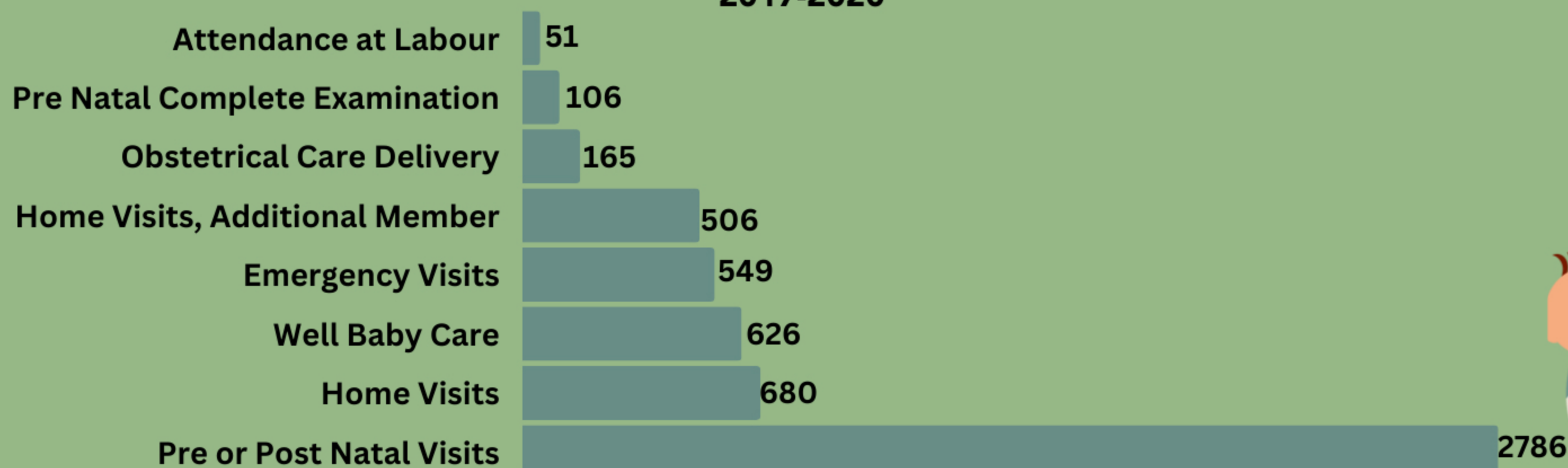
This project uses administrative data to describe midwifery services and clients in NB, from the profession's inception in the province in 2017, through 2020.
