

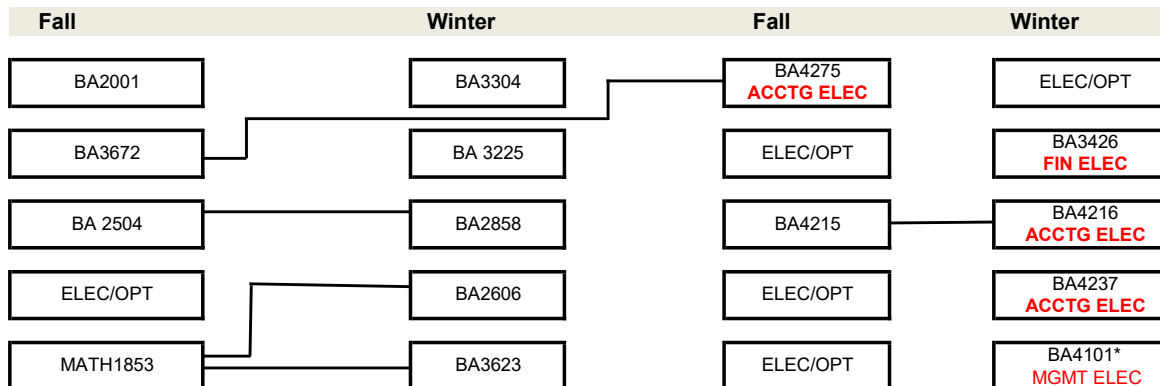

A total of 60 credit hours (chs) are required for the BAM Accounting degree; 27 chs of compulsory courses (MATH1853, BA2001, BA2504, BA2606, BA2858, BA3225, BA3304, BA3623, BA3672, & BA4215) PLUS 9 chs of Accounting elective courses (BA4216, BA4237 & BA4275 are the only electives currently offered), PLUS 3chs of Finance elective chosen from the following BA3426, BA4437, BA4455, ECON3114 or other approved finance course (note BA3426 is required for CPA entry) PLUS 3 ch Elective courses chosen from COMS 2001, SOCI 2413, ECON 2091, 3 chs Psychology or other courses as approved by the Faculty of Business. PLUS 3 ch Business Elective chosen from BA 3123, BA 3134, BA 3557, BA 4101\*, BA 4193 or other business/economics course as approved by the Faculty of Business PLUS 15 ch options, with no more than 6 chs from business/economics.
